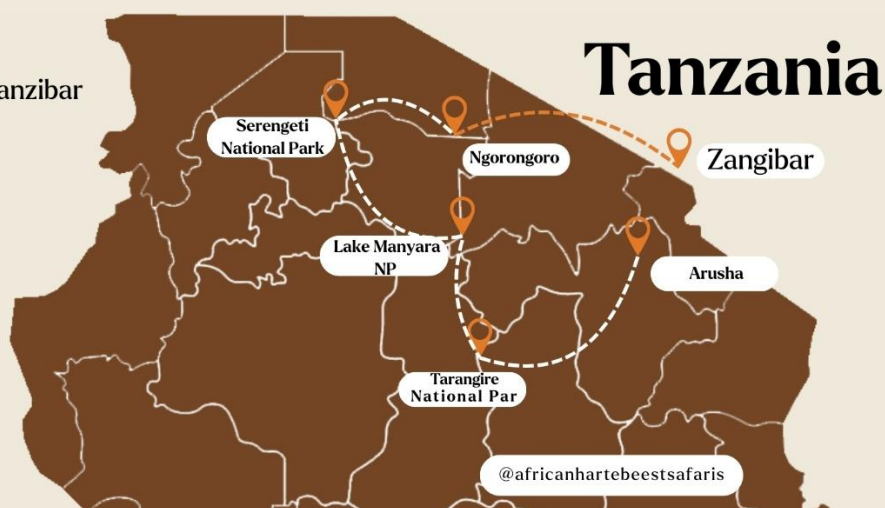

## Day 1: Arrival in Arusha – Welcome to Tanzania

## Day 2 : Tarangire National Park – Giants of the Savannah

After breakfast, drive to Tarangire National Park, famous for its ancient baobab trees and large elephant herds. Enjoy a full-day game drive where you may also spot lions, zebras, wildebeests, and giraffes along the Tarangire River. The park's sparse vegetation makes for excellent wildlife viewing.

Accommodation: Lake Burunge Tented Lodge or similar

Meal Plan: Full Board (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner).



## Day 3 : Lake Manyara National Park – Flamingos & Tree Climbing Lions

This morning, you'll head to Lake Manyara National Park, a lush gem nestled at the base of the Great Rift Valley escarpment. The park is home to diverse ecosystems and is famous for its tree-climbing lions, pink flamingos, hippos, and rich birdlife. Enjoy a scenic picnic lunch and continue your game drive in the afternoon.

Accommodation: Tortilis Lake Manyara or similar

Meal Plan: Full Board (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

## Day 4 : Serengeti National Park Central – Into the Wild

After breakfast, journey into the legendary Serengeti, a vast ecosystem home to the Great Migration and the Big Five. En route, enjoy game drives through the Ngorongoro highlands. Arrive in the central Serengeti in time for an afternoon game drive in this iconic wildlife haven.

Accommodation: Serengeti Heritage Camp or similar

Meal Plan: Full Board (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

## Day 5 : Serengeti National Park – Safari Adventure Continues

Spend the day exploring the vast plains of Serengeti with both morning and afternoon game drives. Depending on the time of



year, you might witness the dramatic river crossings or large predator activity. Expect encounters with cheetahs, elephants, buffalo, and countless other animals.

Accommodation: Serengeti Heritage Camp or similar

Meal Plan: Full Board (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

## Day 6 : : Ngorongoro Crater – Africas Eden

After breakfast, drive to Ngorongoro and descend into the world's largest unbroken volcanic caldera. This UNESCO World Heritage Site offers a high chance of spotting the Big Five in one place. Enjoy a full-day game drive with a picnic lunch by the hippo pool before ascending to the crater rim for overnight.

Accommodation: Ngorongoro Farm House or similar

Meal Plan: Full Board (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

## Day 7 : : Flight to Zanzibar – Relaxing Begins

After breakfast, drive to Arusha for a short flight to Zanzibar. On arrival, you'll be transferred to your beach resort. Spend the rest of the day unwinding by the turquoise waters of the Indian Ocean, soaking in the sun and sea breeze.

Accommodation: Neptune Pwani

## Day 8: : Zanzibar Beach Leisure – Optional

### Water Activities

Enjoy a day of relaxation or explore Zanzibar's vibrant marine world. Optional activities include snorkeling, diving, or a spice



tour. You could also visit Jozani Forest to see the endemic red colobus monkeys.

## Day 9: : Stone Town Tour – Cultural Exploration

After breakfast, take a guided tour of Stone Town, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Explore the old fort, Sultan's Palace, spice markets, and narrow streets rich with Swahili-Arabic architecture. Return to your resort for a sunset dinner.

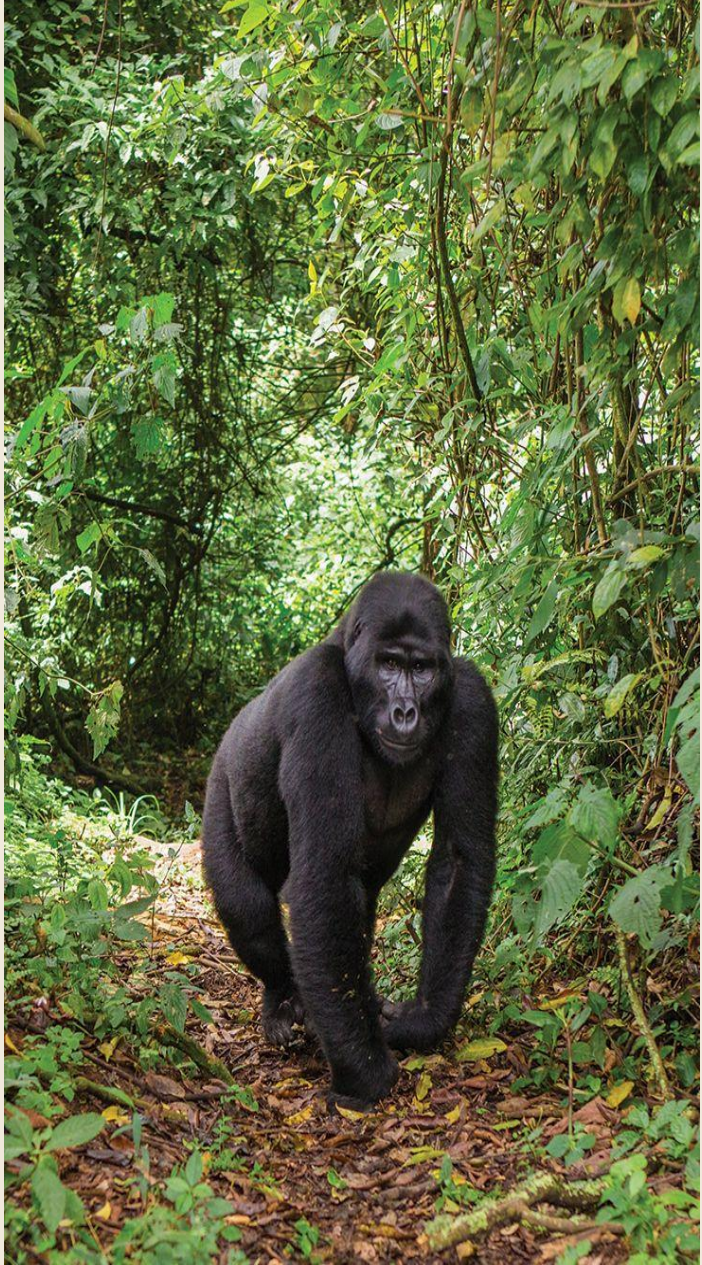
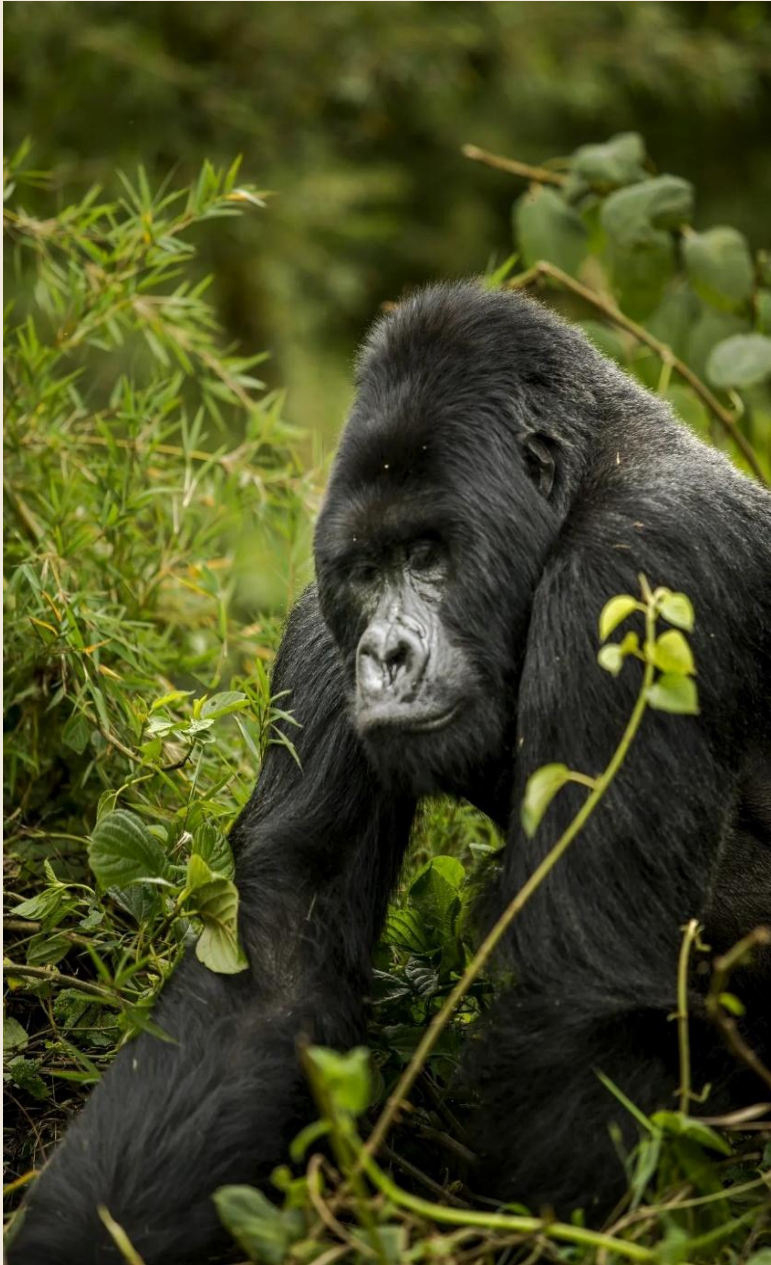
