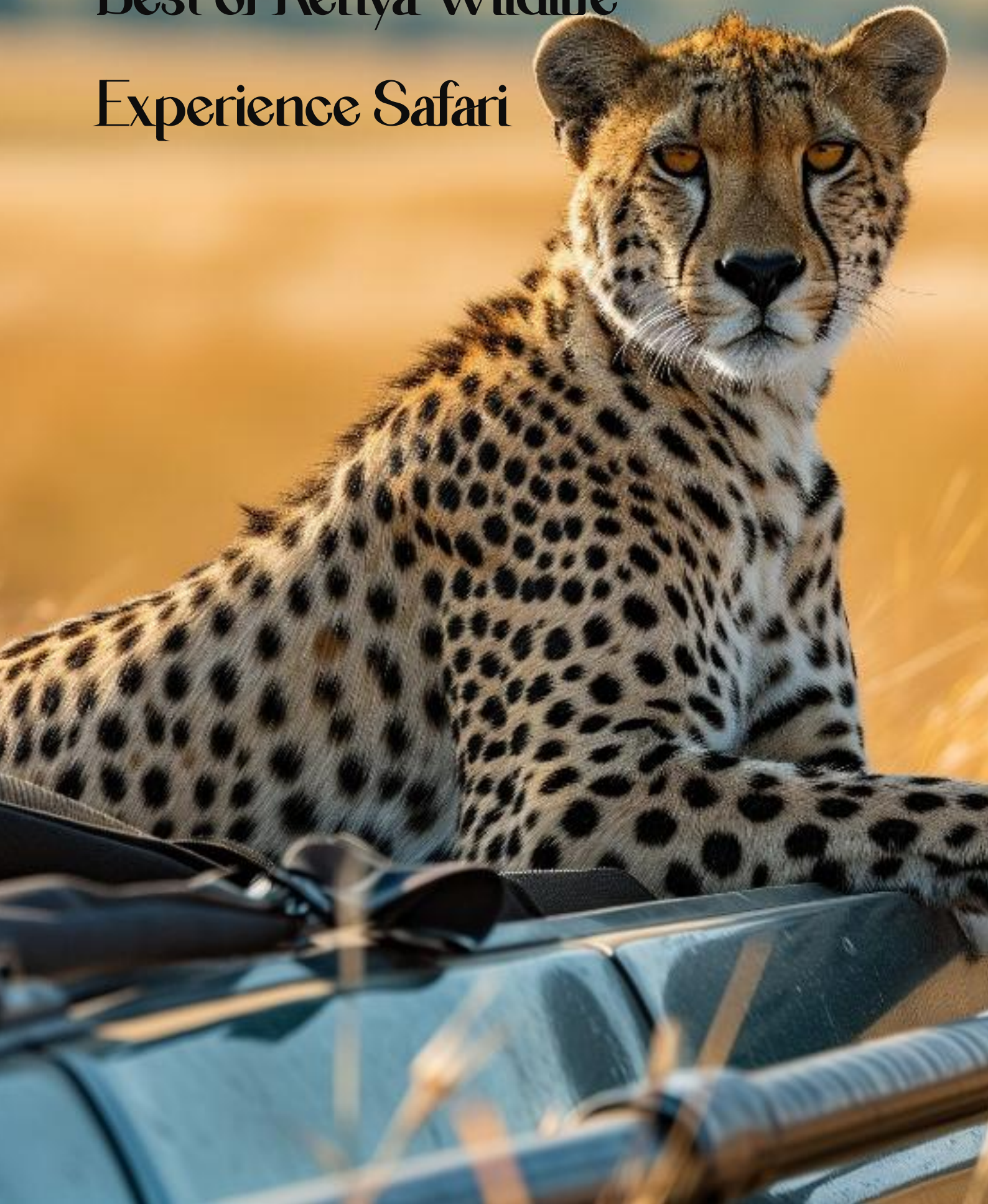

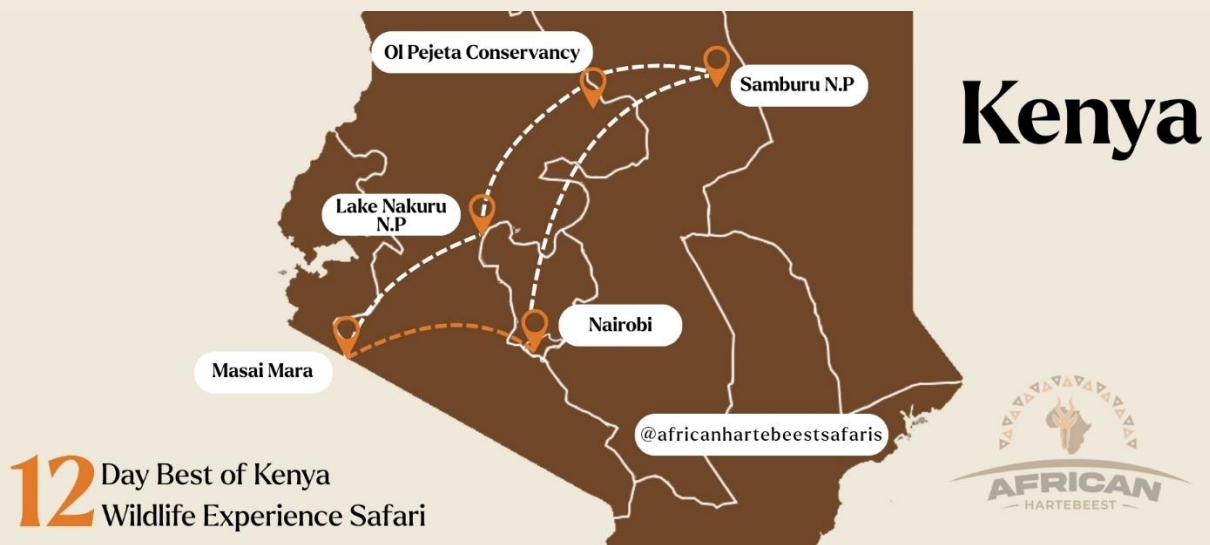


Itinerary Overview

Destination Highlights : : Arrival in Nairobi - Nairobi – Samburu National Reserve - Samburu Exploration - Samburu – Ol Pejeta Conservancy - Ol Pejeta Conservancy - Ol Pejeta – Lake Nakuru National Park Lake Nakuru – Masai Mara National Reserve - Masai Mara Safari - Masai Mara – Nairobi & Departure

This 12-day safari takes you through Kenya's most iconic wildlife destinations, offering a mix of breathtaking landscapes, diverse ecosystems, and abundant wildlife encounters. From the vibrant capital city of Nairobi, head north to the rugged beauty of Samburu, experience the rare species of Ol Pejeta Conservancy, marvel at the flamingo-filled Lake Nakuru, and finish with an unforgettable stay in the legendary Masai Mara, home of the Big Five and the Great Migration (seasonal). The safari is designed to provide a balance of adventure, relaxation, and cultural discovery while staying in handpicked luxury camps and lodges.





Day 1 : Arrival in Nairobi

Upon arrival at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, you will be warmly welcomed by our representative and transferred to your luxury city hotel. Depending on your arrival time, you may relax after your journey or enjoy an optional excursion to the Giraffe Centre or Karen Blixen Museum. Dinner and overnight stay in Nairobi.

Accommodation: Emara Hotel

Meals: Dinner

Day 2 : Nairobi – Samburu National Reserve

After breakfast, transfer to Wilson Airport for a scenic flight to Samburu National Reserve. Upon arrival, you'll be met by your driver-guide and enjoy a game drive en route to the lodge.



Samburu is known for its striking landscape of rugged hills, arid plains, and the Ewaso Nyiro River, which attracts diverse wildlife. Look out for the “Samburu Special Five”: Grevy’s zebra, Somali ostrich, reticulated giraffe, Beisa oryx, and gerenuk. Afternoon game drive followed by dinner and overnight.

Accommodation: Elephant Bedroom Camp

Meals: Full Board

Day 3&4 : Samburu Exploration

Spend two full days exploring Samburu with morning and afternoon game drives. The park is home to elephants, lions, leopards, cheetahs, and abundant birdlife. You may also visit a Samburu village for a cultural experience and gain insights into their traditional way of life. Between game drives, relax at your lodge with panoramic views of the rugged landscapes.

Accommodation: Elephant Bedroom Camp

Meals: Full Board

Day 5: Samburu – Ol Pejeta Conservancy

After breakfast, fly or drive to Ol Pejeta Conservancy, a unique sanctuary located on the Laikipia Plateau. Famous for its endangered species conservation, Ol Pejeta is home to the last



two northern white rhinos, a large population of black rhinos, and a chimpanzee sanctuary. Afternoon game drive in the conservancy with chances to see the Big Five. Dinner and overnight at the camp.

Accommodation: Sweetwaters Serena Camp

Meals: Full Board

Day 6: Ol Pejeta Conservancy

Enjoy a full day of safari activities in Ol Pejeta. Take morning and evening game drives, visit the rhino sanctuary, and enjoy the chance to see lions, elephants, and wild dogs. Optional activities include horseback riding safaris or night game drives to see nocturnal wildlife.

Accommodation: Sweetwaters Serena Camp

Meals: Full Board

Day 7: Ol Pejeta – Lake Nakuru National Park

Depart after breakfast for Lake Nakuru National Park. On arrival, enjoy a game drive en route to your lodge. Lake Nakuru is world-famous for its flocks of flamingos, pelicans, and diverse



bird species. The park also shelters rhinos, Rothschild's giraffes, lions, and leopards. Dinner and overnight overlooking the lake.

Accommodation: Sarova Lion Hill Lodge

Meals: Full Board

Day 8 :Lake Nahuru – Masai Mara National Reserve

After breakfast, transfer to the airstrip for your flight to the Masai Mara. Upon arrival, enjoy a game drive en route to your luxury camp. The Masai Mara is Kenya's premier safari destination, famed for its rolling savannah, dense wildlife population, and the seasonal Great Migration. Afternoon game drive followed by dinner and overnight.

Accommodation: Sarova Mara

Meals: Full Board

Day 9-11 :Masai Mara Safari

Spend three full days on safari in the Masai Mara. Each day includes morning and afternoon game drives, with the option of a full-day game drive with picnic lunch. Spot the Big Five and



witness thrilling predator-prey interactions. Optional activities include a hot air balloon safari over the savannah followed by a champagne breakfast, or a visit to a Maasai village for a cultural encounter.

Accommodation: Saruni Mara / Mara Serena Safari Lodge / Ashnil Mara Camp (Full Board).

Meals: Full Board

Day 12 : Masai Mara – Nairobi & Departure

Enjoy a final early morning game drive, followed by breakfast at the camp. Transfer to the airstrip for your flight back to Nairobi. Upon arrival, you'll be met and transferred to Jomo Kenyatta International Airport for your onward flight.

Meals: Breakfast only.

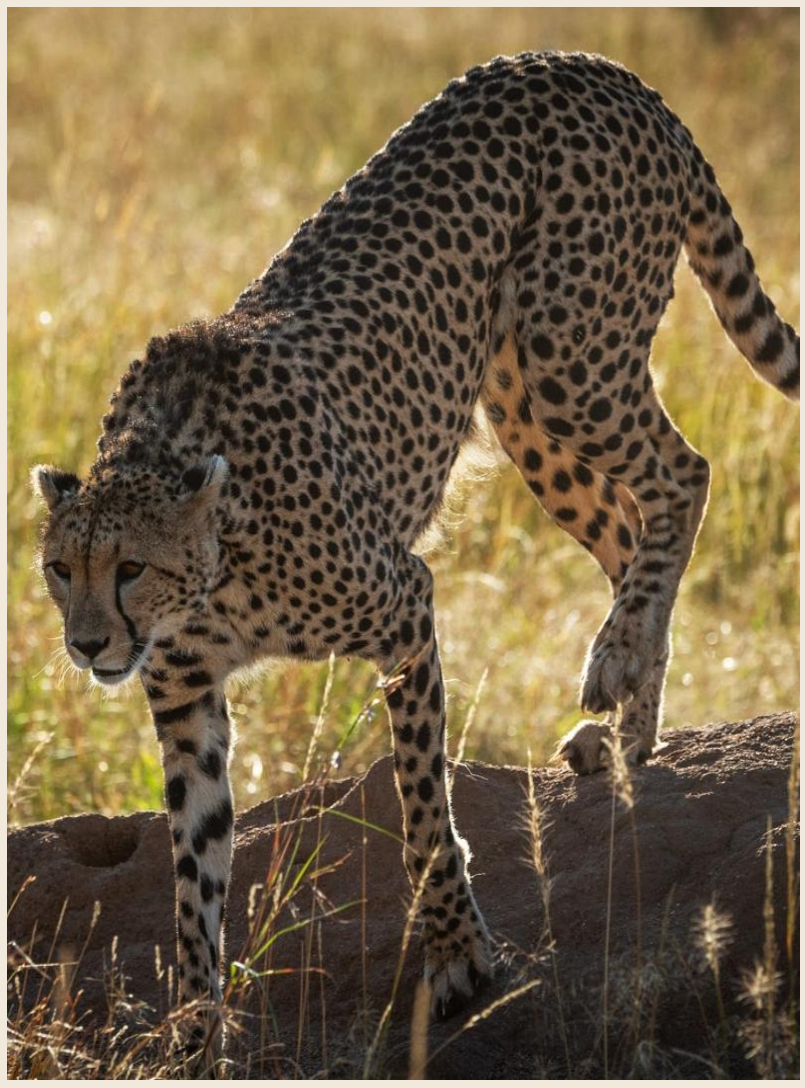
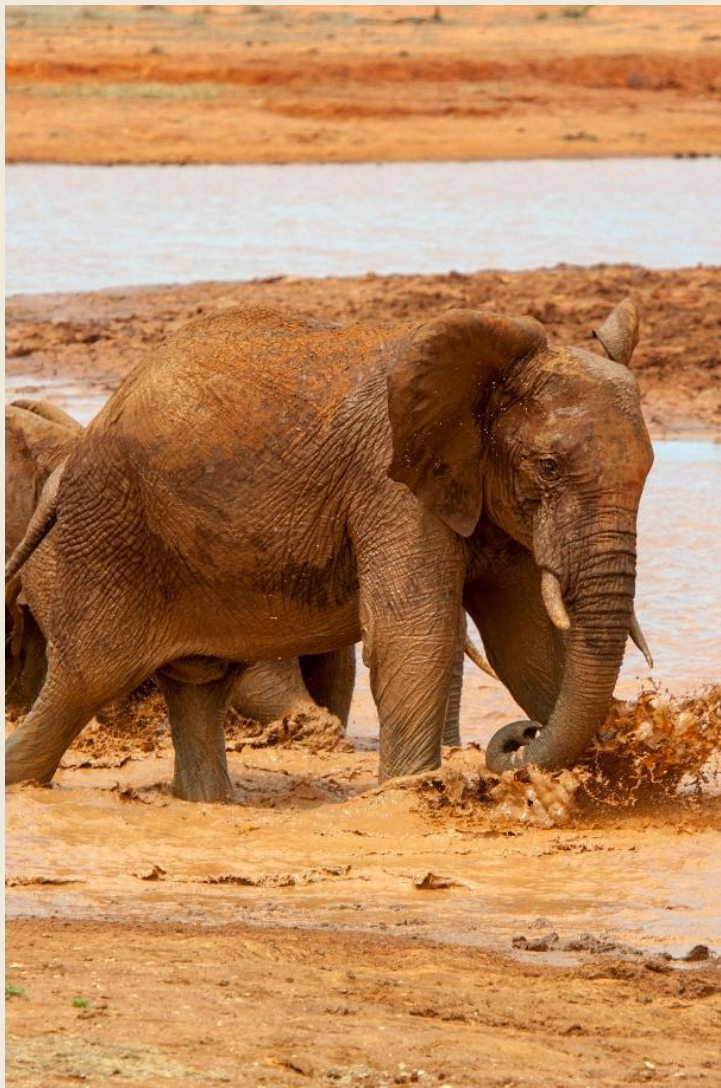
What's Included
