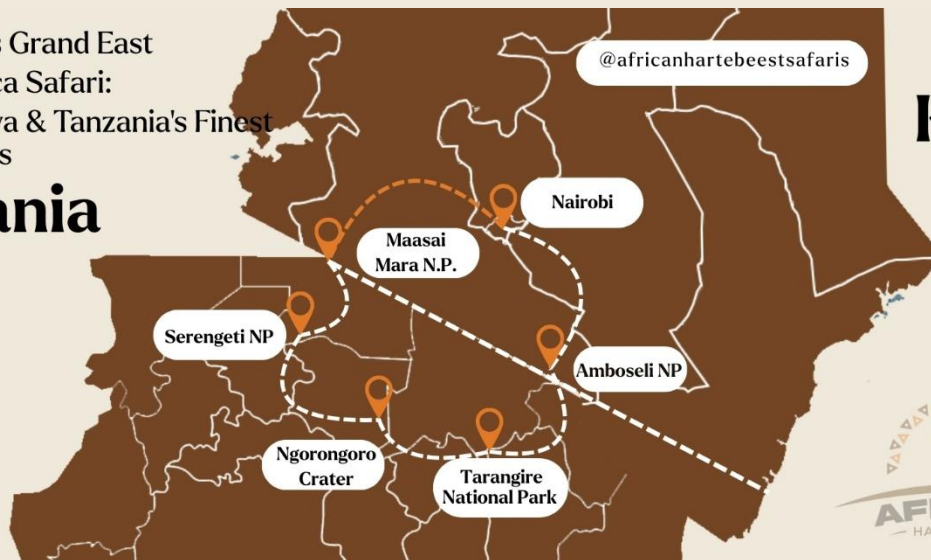

## Day 1 : Arrival in Nairobi – Africa's Vibrant Safari

### Capital

Arrive at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, where your personal safari concierge greets you with refreshing drinks and cold towels. Transfer to your luxurious suite in Nairobi's most exclusive neighbourhood. After settling in, enjoy a leisurely lunch at the hotel's signature restaurant. In the afternoon, visit the Daphne Sheldrick Elephant Orphanage for an up-close encounter with orphaned baby elephants, then head to the Giraffe Centre to feed endangered Rothschild giraffes. Return for sundowner cocktails and a gourmet dinner.

## Day 2: Nairobi's Cultural Heritage

After breakfast, visit the Karen Blixen Museum, once home to the famed "Out of Africa" author. Explore its gardens and colonial-era furnishings before heading to



Kazuri Beads Women's Cooperative to see exquisite handmade jewelry created by local artisans. Enjoy lunch at the Talisman Restaurant, then spend the afternoon relaxing at your hotel's spa or pool. The evening features a farm-to-table dinner crafted with fresh Kenyan produce.

## Day 3 : Journey to Amboseli – Land of Giants

Enjoy an early breakfast before driving through Maasai country toward Amboseli National Park. Stop for your first breathtaking view of Mount Kilimanjaro. Upon arrival, settle into your luxury tent and enjoy lunch. In the afternoon, embark on a game drive across Amboseli's plains, where elephants roam freely beneath Africa's highest peak. Return for sundowners by the fire and dinner under the stars.

## Day 4: Amboseli Immersion

Set out at dawn for a sunrise game drive, the best time to see predators in action. Return for a lavish bush breakfast, then enjoy leisure time until your afternoon visit to a Maasai village, learning about their culture and traditions. In the evening, embark on a birdwatching game drive before a private bush dinner with Maasai singers.

## Day 5: Cross into Tanzania – Arusha

After breakfast, cross the border into Tanzania, passing through scenic highlands and enjoying views of Mount Meru. Arrive at your Arusha hotel for lunch and spend the afternoon relaxing in the gardens or at the spa. Dinner is a fine dining experience highlighting Tanzanian flavors.

## Day 6: Tarangire National Park – Elephant Paradise

Depart early for Tarangire National Park, pausing at the Great Rift Valley viewpoint. Enter the park to see herds of elephants among ancient baobabs. Enjoy a picnic lunch overlooking the Tarangire River before an afternoon game drive in search of rare species like the fringe-eared oryx. Arrive at your treetop lodge for sundowners on your deck.

Accommodation: Tarangire Treetops

## Day 7: Ngorongoro Highlands Arrival

In the morning, enjoy a morning game drive in Tarangire, ascend to the Ngorongoro Highlands. Stop at a local market for a taste of village life. Arrive at your crater-rim lodge for lunch, followed by a guided nature walk with a Maasai guide. Enjoy cocktails by the fireplace as the sun sets over the crater.

## Day8 : Ngorongoro Crater Exploration

Descend into the Ngorongoro Crater at dawn for a full day of wildlife viewing. Spot black rhinos, elephants, and big cats in this “Garden of Eden.” Enjoy a champagne picnic by a hippo pool before exploring quieter parts of the crater. Return to your lodge for a spa session and a gourmet dinner.

## Day9: Fly to the Serengeti – Endless Plains

Fly to the Serengeti for three days of game drives tailored to the Great Migration’s location. Track herds and predators, enjoy bush breakfasts, and starlit dinners.

## Day10: Serengeti Safari Adventures

Spend the day exploring a different region of the Serengeti. Witness dramatic wildlife interactions and photograph the park's landscapes. Enjoy a picnic lunch in the wild before returning for sunset drinks and dinner.

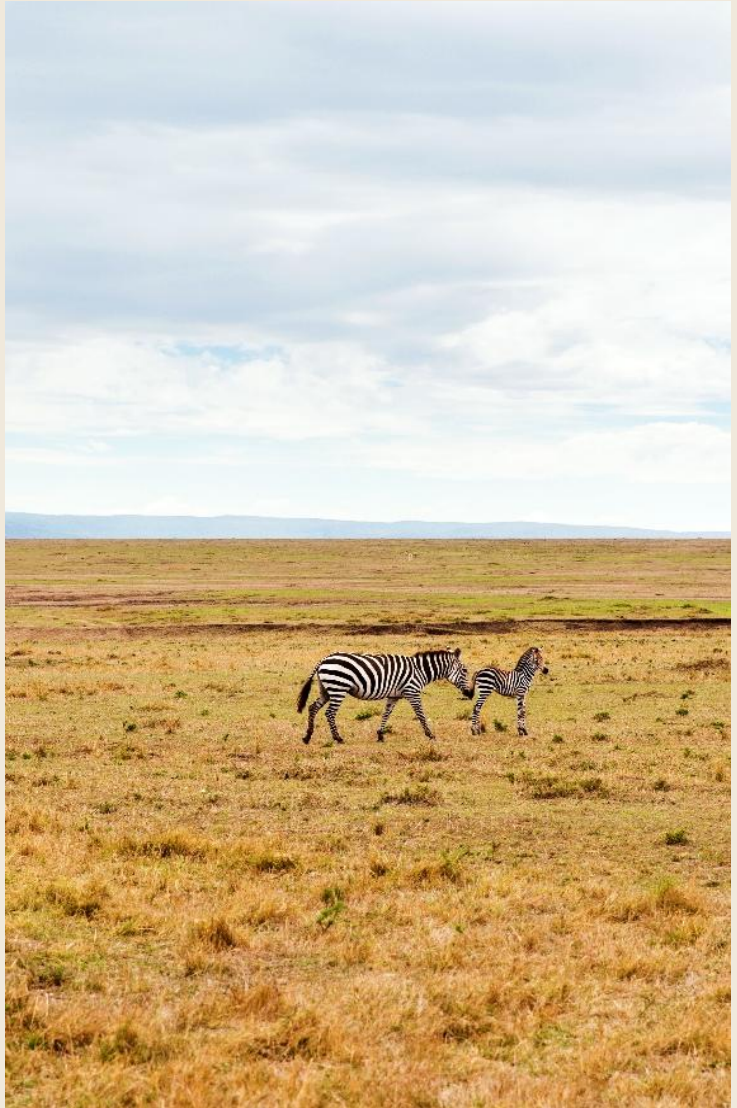
