



# Ifinerary Overview

Destination Highlights : : Arrival in Nairobi- Nairobi to Aberdares - Aberdares to Lake Nakuru National Park : Lake Nakuru to Masai Mara National Reserve - Full Day in the Masai Mara Masai Mara back to Nairobi

This 6-day safari offers a snapshot of Kenya's most cherished destinations. Begin with an overnight in Nairobi, allowing you to rest and acclimatize before heading to the lush mountain landscapes of the Aberdares.



## Day 1: Arrival in Nairobi

Upon landing at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, you will be greeted by our representative and transferred to your Nairobi hotel. Spend the afternoon at leisure, unwinding from your journey or exploring optional city attractions such as the Karen Blixen Museum or the Giraffe Centre. In the evening, settle into your room for a comfortable overnight stay, ready to begin your safari adventure the following day.

## Day 2 : Nairobi to Aberdares

Awake to the sounds of nature and depart for an early morning game drive, capturing wildlife at its most active. The Ewaso Nyiro River flows through Samburu, attracting elephants, lions, and other animals seeking water in this semi-arid region. Keep your eyes peeled for predators such as cheetahs and leopards, often seen resting in the shade or perched atop rocks scanning for prey. Return to your accommodation for lunch and a midday rest before heading out again in the late afternoon. As dusk settles, return to camp for dinner, recounting the day's adventures around a campfire or in the dining area.

## Day 3 Aberdares to Lake Nakuru National Park

After an early breakfast, depart the Aberdares and descend into the Great Rift Valley, marveling at breathtaking views along the way. Arrive at Lake Nakuru National Park by midday, where you will head to your lodge or camp for lunch. In the afternoon, embark on a game drive around the lake's shores, famous for their seasonal display of pink flamingos. Keep

an eye out for black and white rhinos, which thrive in this protected area, and you may also spot leopards lounging ithe acacia trees. Conclude the day with dinner and an overnight stay at your lodge, listening to the wildlife activity around the lake

## Day 4: Lake Nakuru to Masai Mara National Reserve

Rise early for breakfast, then set off toward the southwest en route to the Masai Mara. As you cross the Rift Valley floor and approach the Mara region, you'll notice the landscape shifting to rolling grasslands dotted with lone acacia trees. Arrive at your lodge or tented camp in time for lunch, followed by a short rest. In the late afternoon, head out on your first Masai Mara game drive, scanning the plains for elephants, giraffes, zebras, and big cats such as lions and cheetahs. Return at sunset to your accommodation for dinner, reflecting on the day's exciting wildlife encounters.

## DaY5: Full Day in the Masai Mara

After an early breakfast, depart Lake Nakuru and continue your drive along the floor of the Great Rift Valley to the Masai Mara National Reserve. Arrive in time for lunch at your Masai Mara lodge or tented camp. In the late afternoon, embark on your first Mara game drive, venturing into rolling grasslands and acacia-dotted plains teeming with wildlife. Look out for giraffes, zebras, elephants, and the iconic big cats—lions, cheetahs, and leopards—often seen on the prowl. Before nightfall, return to your lodge, enjoy a sumptuous dinner, and settle in for a peaceful evening surrounded by nature's nocturnal sounds.

#### DaY 6: Masai Mara back to Nairobi

Bid farewell to the Masai Mara on one last early morning game drive, seizing any remaining photo opportunities. After returning to the lodge for breakfast, gather your belongings and depart for Nairobi. Arrive in the city by mid to late afternoon, where you'll be dropped off at your hotel or Jomo Kenyatta International Airport for your onward journey. This marks the end of your 6-day safari, having journeyed from Nairobi's urban energy to the misty heights of the Aberdares, the flamingo-fringed shores of Lake Nakuru, and the wildlife-rich plains of the Masai Mara.
