Embark on a compelling 7 night safari with African Hartebeest Safaris, combining the wild heart of Laikipia with the iconic plains of the Maasai Mara. Start at Lewa House, a hilltop conservancy retreat immersed in rhino protection and rare wildlife. Continue to Segera Retreat, offering camel safaris, night drives, and community encounters amid rolling hills with Mount Kenya as backdrop. The journey concludes at Bateleur Camp, on the edge of the Mara Reserve—with prime big cat viewing and potential wildebeest river crossings. With light air transfers, expert guides, and luxury lodges, these itinerary balances conservation education, culture, and authentic Kenyan safari adventure.





## Day 1: Arrival to Lewa's Rhino Heights

Flight from Nairobi's Wilson or Jomo Kenyatta Airport to Laikipia, followed by a scenic transfer to Lewa House. Settle in and enjoy your first drinks and conservation briefing overlooking Mount Kenya and Lewa's rolling hills.

## Day 2 : Rhino Safaris & Community Encounters

Spend the day driving through Lewa Wildlife Conservancy in search of black rhino, Grevy's zebra, elephant, and more.

Afternoon optional activity: guided walking safari, camel ride, or community Maasai village visit.

## Day 3: Segera Camel Rides & Night Drives

Transfer to Segera Retreat, perched on Laikipia's hilltops. Post-lunch, enjoy camel safaris or guided walks before a sundowner overlooking the vast conservancy. Option to do a night drive under starlit skies.

## Day 4: Flexible Wildlife Day & Stargazing

Choose from diverse activities at Segera—from balloon rides to museum visits, game drives to nature walks. Relax at the infinity pool or join a traditional boma cultural excursion.

## DaY5: Mara Bound Flight to Bateleur Camp

Fly to the Maasai Mara in the morning. Arrive at Bateleur Camp, set against lush forest and grassland. After lunch, enjoy your first Mara game drive, followed by sundowners beside the river.

## DaY 6: Mara Magic Big Five & River Crossings

Full day of morning and afternoon game drives in pursuit of lions, leopards, elephants, and zebra herds. If timed (Jul–Oct), witness the great migration river crossings.

Enjoy a final morning game drive before brunch at camp. Midday transfer to the airstrip for your flight back to Nairobi, or onward arrangements.



